Ms. Westberg and Mrs. Merriam have allowed her to have a voice. She can fully embrace who she is as an individual, she is now proud of who she is. She has friends with likenesses the same as her. On May 12, 2018 the club is hosting a Youth Summit. Entertainment, parent workshops, topics such as acceptance and influence from social media will be discussed amongst the youth and there will be Key Note Speakers. This includes Grades 5 -12 students.

There are 20+ in the club. Statistics state 10% of our school population would identify as something other than male or female. YRHS then would have an estimated 80 students identifying as something other than male or female. This would suggest we are "breaking ground", but we have many other students that may eventually join this club.

We have changed our SRC Constitution to reflect and support the Admin Procedure. Starting next year our SRC will be represented by one president and three vice-presidents – doesn't matter on gender.
